- 4. Submit a video and PDF file of the model explanation through the google
- 5. Please note Judge's decision will be final.
- 6. Most promising models will be given a chance to present their idea through a PowerPoint presentation, in a virtual online meeting to be held on **21 Sept 2021.**

Rules for the Preparation of the Model

1. Prepare the model/chart based on the theme "Transformation/Evolution of the Pharma Products"

e.g Discovery of the aspirin from the extract of the willow bark (in Ancient Greek era) to the DISPRIN tablet (in modern era, as a marketed preparation)

- 2. Choose any one product (Pharmaceutical as well as Cosmetic) as explained in above example to exhibit its evolution throughout the years.
- 3. Use cardboard, paper, adhesive tapes, colours and supplementary things (empty product containers) required to define the history of the product chosen.
- 4. Record a video of the model explanation along with all the team members (if possible) against a clear and bright background in high defined picture quality.
